'manager', sharpening their math and interpersonal skills. The credit union also works with parents by offering financial literacy workshops after school hours.

School Principal Raine Hackler addressed the familial aspect of the collaboration, saying, "We want to demystify the process of saving for something as daunting as college. As a parent, it can be overwhelming to prioritize saving for something so far on the horizon—especially when life's demands can be unpredictable. We want to create a simple solution for saving that allows our vision of best preparing our students for the future, and of strengthening each family in our school community."

President and CEO of Carolina Foothills, Scott Weaver said, "Our staff has been energized by the enthusiasm of the parents and students for this program, putting us very close to 100% participation, and proving that savings mobilization is a much needed and desired part of the overall educational offering at Meeting Street Academy. Engaging each week with the students, watching their savings grow, makes us feel that we are giving them the tools they need to be successful and its the highlight of our week!"

Meeting Street Academy is an early childhood education program dedicated to providing high-quality educational opportunities to young students, with a focus on family partnership. Founded in Charleston in 2008, Meeting Street Academy-Spartanburg opened downtown in July 2012 and currently serves 156 students ages 3-8 from across Spartanburg County. Meeting Street Academy is partnering with Spartanburg School District 7, beginning in July 2016, to provide a public-private education to students living within an agreed upon attendance zone.
