



## CDFI Credit Union Impact

Community Development Financial Institutions (CDFIs) must meet stringent criteria to become certified. CDFI credit unions must:

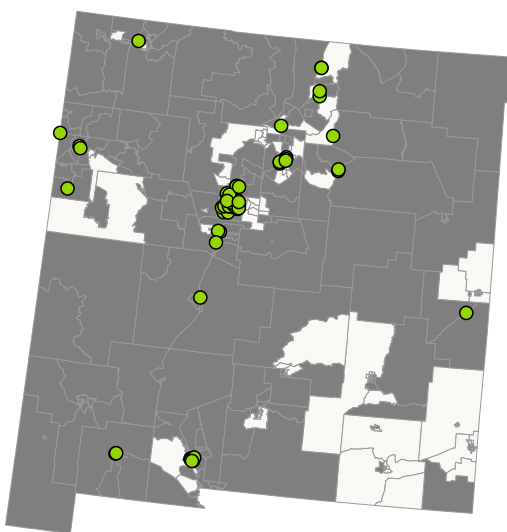
- Direct at least 60% of their lending toward economically distressed people and communities, and
- Build members' capacity to manage credit, increase savings, and increase their financial well-being.

### New Mexico's 8 CDFI Credit Unions:

- Have combined assets of **\$8.2 billion**
- Serve **510,319** members through **78** branch locations

### New Mexico's CDFI Credit Unions achieve impact through **\$5.4 billion** in active loans to members, including:

- **\$1.1 billion** in community mortgage lending
- **\$2.4 billion** in local consumer financing
- **\$1.5 billion** in lending to local businesses
- **\$402.9 million** in affordable small-dollar lending
