Repro Systems, a family-run architecture and construction business, is just one of many businesses that were able to rehire employees they had been forced to let go

because of the COVID-19 pandemic. Congressman Neal, an author of the CARES Act, expressed satisfaction that Repro Systems and businesses like it were receiving help, just as the legislation had intended.
