Given that PPP 2.0 got off to a bumpy start this morning, where many of you have reported a number of challenges with the e-Tran platform, we've decided to postpone tomorrow's Town Hall call. The next session will be held next week, Tuesday, May 5. We are closely monitoring the situation and relaying information from our members to the House's Small Business Committee to highlight the challenges CDFIs, MDIs and community lenders are experiencing, particularly when SBA itself is making it easier for high volume lenders to submit batches of at least 5,000 loans.

We're waiting to hear from the US Treasury Department about a call they'd like to do with the SBA and the CDFI Fund, specifically for CDFI credit unions. Stay tuned for that.
