

ECONOMIC IMPACT PAYMENTS

Who Needs to Take Action

Anyone with a tax filing obligation who has not filed a tax return for 2019 or 2018 should electronically file their 2019 return to receive their payment. Taxpayers should include direct deposit information for their refund when they file to get the Economic Impact Payment as quickly as possible. Taxpayers who owe tax can use

Get My Payment after their return is processed to provide bank account information.





Social Security, SSDI, SSI, Railroad Retirement recipients and veterans who do not usually file a tax return will automatically receive a \$1,200 payment. VA and SSI recipients with qualifying children can use the *Non-Filers: Enter Payment Info Here* tool to claim \$500 per child – but only until May 5.

Other people who aren't required to file a tax return such as low-income individuals may be eligible for a payment. Individuals can see if they are <u>eligible</u> for an Economic Impact Payment on IRS.gov. Eligible people should use the <u>Non-Filers:</u> <u>Enter Payment Info Here</u> tool on IRS.gov to get their payment.
